



GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Create a mini campfire at home and join Unite and Cumbrae Camp at Home on Friday 22nd May at 9pm for a campfire and hot chocolate.

- You'll need appropriate tinder materials. Tinder is small, dry and highly flammable materials to help catch the flame. A natural tinder would be dry grass, however if you can't find that then cotton wool will work.
- 2) Inside a tin foil tray, build a fire by creating a small pile of dry sticks. Leave a gap near the bottom to place your tinder.
- Using matches or a lighter carefully ignite your tinder. 3)
- Gently blow on the flame to boost the oxygen and grow the flame. This should help light the small pile of sticks.
- Manage the fire by ensuring there is enough fuel (sticks) for the fire. Once finished, carefully extinguish the fire with a bucket of water.
